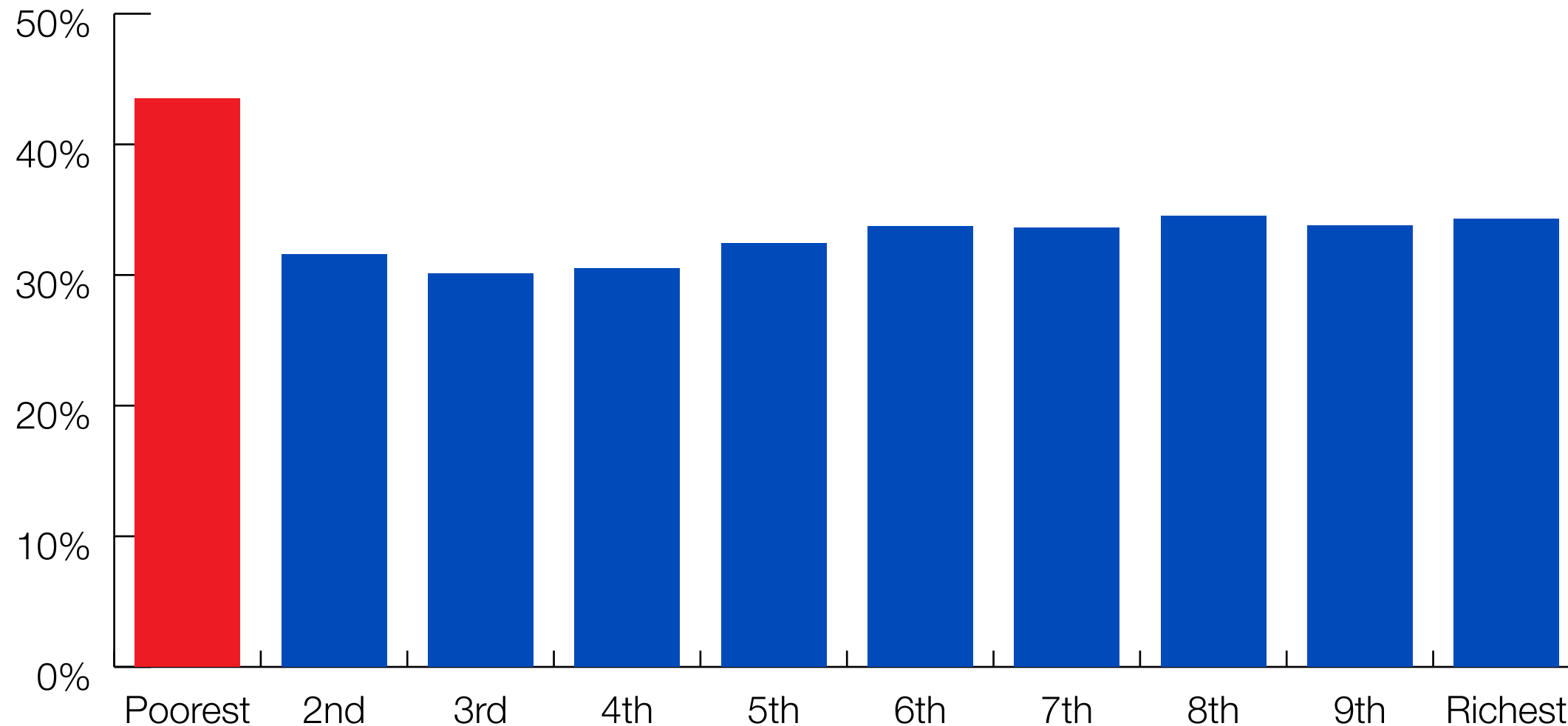


The poorest pay the highest level of taxes

The poorest 10% of UK citizens pay 43.5% of their income in taxes. This is 10% more than the rest of the population who pay an average tax rate of 32.7%
