## **Different Worldview, Different Person-Centered Plan**

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Context defines the practice and contribution of person-centered planning. In *Reinventing Organizations* Frederic Laloux accounts for the evolution of organizational forms by describing the effects of a succession of worldviews. I've adapted his schema to distinguish two ways to conduct person centered planning and situate the difference in the effects of contrasting worldviews. Worldviews mix, so an organization operating in the context of a mechanistic worldview can intentionally create a space expressing an evolutionary worldview, perhaps as a development strategy or a crisis response.
